

RADOVLJICA: RADOL'CA – HONESTLY SWEET

Radol'ca is a tourist destination which extends over the entire area of the Municipality of Radovljica. It encompasses the town of Radovljica, the villages of Begunje na Gorenjskem, Brezje, Kropa (with the Lipnica Valley), and the town of Lesce. The name Radol'ca (the term locals use to refer to the town of Radovljica and sometimes also its wider area) is deliberately different from the name of Radovljica as it is intended to be understood as a synonym for the entire region.

The preserved technical heritage bears witness to the utilisation of natural resources and the diligence of the locals; the preserved architectural heritage is testament to their creativity and use of locally available materials.
